As part of the implementation of activity related to self-employment of young graduates of Higher Education, the **Ministry of Livestock** through the **Livestock and Fish Farming Value Chain Development Projects (PDCV)**, has launched a call for applications for the incubation of 275 young Cameroonians of both sexes, interested in professionalization in the Livestock and Fish Farming Value Chains (cattle, pig and fish).

These young Cameroonians will be trained and supported in order to create their own jobs and employ others. **Limbe Nautical Arts and Fisheries Institute (LINAFI)** is an incubation Centre of the project and 25 of the selected applicants will be train in LINAFI.

Conditions for eligibility:

- ❖ Be of **Cameroonian nationality**
- ❖ Be a graduate of Higher Education aged between 18 and 35
- ❖ Have a business idea link to Livestock or Fish Farming Value Chain
- ❖ Choose LINAFI as a host structure for incubation
- ❖ A Curriculum Vitae
- ❖ Certified copies of birth certificate, Diploma and National Identity Card
- ❖ A medical certificate issued by an authorized Doctor and a non-conviction
- ❖ Documents supporting the candidate's business idea.
